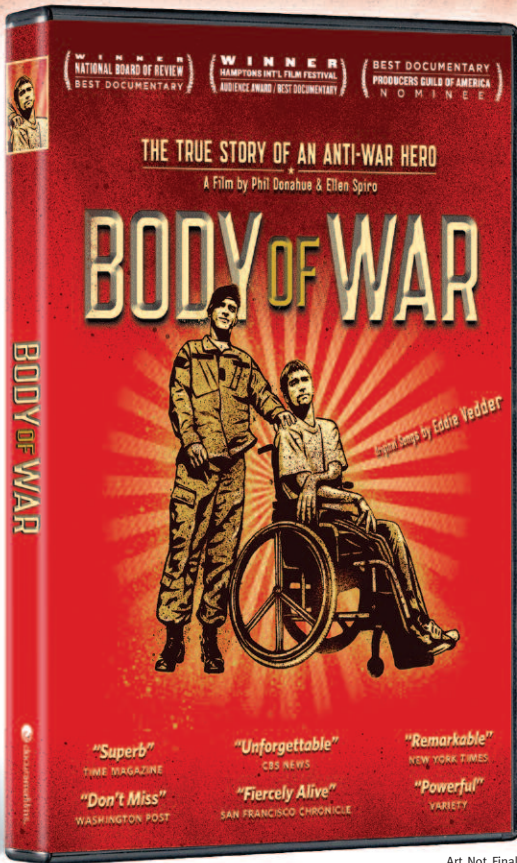


BODY OF WAR

Paralyzed from the chest down after serving in Iraq for just one week, 25-year-old Tomas Young is forced to deal with the realities of war every day. For Tomas, learning to cope with his disability means finding his voice to speak out against the war in Iraq.
